Chhattisgarh Pre Agricultural Test CG PAT 2018

CG PAT (Chhattisgarh Pre-Agricultural Test) is organized by the **Chhattisgarh Professional Examination Board** (CPEB). It is a state level entrance exam for providing admission to students in B.Sc Agriculture & B.Sc Horticulture under colleges affiliated Indira Gandhi Agricultural University (also known as Indira Gandhi Krishi Vidyalaya IGKV) .

Eligibility for CG PAT

- Candidates should be an Indian citizen and domicile of Chhattisgarh.
- Candidates must have attained 16 years of age by August 2018
- Candidates must have passed class XII or equivalent exam from any recognized board such as CBSE, CISCE, or State Board. Candidates who are appearing in class XII Board examinations are also eligible to apply.
- Candidates must have studied Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Life Sciences as mandatory subjects in XI & XII

Important Dates

- Last date for application with online fee : 03rd May 2018
- Admit cards will be available from : 24th May 2018
- Date of Examination (CG PAT) : 31st May 2018

Application Procedure

- Visit the official website of CG Vyapam (www.cgvyapam.choice.gov.in/) & click on application form.
- Select the group of your choice i.e PCM (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics) or PCB(Physics Chemistry Biology) and domicile.
- Fill up the application form by providing the personal information, educational details ,medium of communication ,exam centres etc
- Upload scanned the photograph and signature in the valid format & size and click on submit tab to follow the next steps.

Application Fee

- The application fee is Rs. 300/- for General, Rs. 250/- for OBC and Rs. 200/- for SC/ST/PWD category candidates.
- The application fee can be submitted through downloaded Challan of State Bank Of India in any branch of SBI on or before the last date.
- Aspirants can also deposit the fee through online mode (Net Banking, Credit Card and Debit Card)

Examination Pattern

- The question paper will consist of 200 Multiple choice questions
- Duration of the exam will be 2 hours.
- The question paper will be divided into the three portions.

Section	Subject	Questions
1	Physics	60MCQ
2	Chemistry	60MCQ
3	Mathematics /Biology	80MCQ

- The exam will be conducted through offline mode i.e. paper-pen based test.
- Each correct answer will carry 1 mark. There will be no negative marking.
- Question paper will be in English and Hindi.
