RIE Common Entrance Examination 2018

Applications are invited for the Regional Institute of Education (RIE) Common Entrance Examination (CEE)-2018 to admit students in the Integrated Academic Programmes (B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed.) offered by Regional Institutes of Education of NCERT at Ajmer, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Mysore, Shillong for the academic session 2018-19

Eligibility for RIE CEE

- Candidates who have cleared their class XII examination in Science ,Commerce & Humanities /Arts stream with at least 50% marks are eligible to apply for RIE CEE 2018
- Candidates who have appeared for their class XII examination in 2018 in the above mentioned streams are eligible to apply for this examination .

NOTE: The eligibility criteria differ for various programmes therefore interested candidates must read Information Brochure (available on the official website) to ascertain their eligibility before applying

Application Procedure

- Visit the official website (www.ncert-cee.kar.nic.in)
- On the homepage, click the “Apply Now” link under NCERT Common Entrance Examination (CEE) – 2018 section or directly click NCERT CEE 2018 Registration Form to register yourself . The “RIE CEE Registration Form” will appear on the screen
- Complete the Registration Form and click “Submit” button to get User Id and Password.
- Finally candidates can Login with user ID and password , fill the RIE CEE application form, pay the NCERT CEE 2018 exam fees and complete the application process.

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Important Dates

- Last date for application : 07th May 2018
- Admit cards will be available from : 14th May to 08th June 2018
- Last date for submitting the marks of Qualifying Examinations : 28th June 2018

Examination Pattern

- The question paper will consist of 80 Multiple choice questions
- Duration of the exam will be 2 hours.
- The question paper will be divided into the three sections.

Section	Subject	Questions	Marks
1	Language Proficiency in English	20	40
2	Teaching Aptitude /Attitude	30	60
3	Reasoning Ability	30	60

- The exam will be conducted through offline mode i.e. paper-pen based test.
- Each correct answer will carry 2 marks. There will be negative marking (0.25 marks) for each incorrect answer.
- Question paper will be in English and Hindi except the section in Language Proficiency in English.

Selection

- Selection of candidates will be merit based
- For selection ,60 % weightage will be given to the scores in entrance examination & 40% weightage to aggregate scores in the qualifying examination.
