The National De-worming Day is again being observed on 10.08.2017 (Thu) by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India with the objective of de-worming children within the age group of 1-19 years.

De-worming means giving a medicine to an individual to get him/her rid of human parasites such as roundworm, flukes, tapeworm etc. Normally de-worming must be done after every six months for each individual.

Under this program, the Government is providing free medicine (Albendazole – chewable tablet) which will be distributed by the school on 10.08.2017 (Thu) to each student, as per the guidelines of the Govt.

In case your child is allergic to this medicine or you have any objection, please ask your ward to convey the same to his/her Class Teacher so that the medicine is not provided to your ward.

Uniform System of Assessment in CBSE

In view of the recent examination reforms initiated by the Board, it has been decided to implement the Uniform system of Assessment for Classes IV-VIII.

• Evaluation of Scholastic areas: In general, for the purpose of the Uniform system of Assessment an academic year has been divided into two terms. The first term will be from April – September, and the second term from October – March.

Each term will have a Periodic Test of 40 marks and a Term End Exam of 80 marks (half yearly / yearly exam) for evaluation of Scholastic areas. 40 marks periodic test will be converted into 10 marks.





इ) अच्छा भोजन खाने की आदत विकसित करें: फास्ट फूड, जंक फूड आदि से बचें, क्योंकि उनका आपके स्वास्थ्य पर

नकारात्मक प्रभाव पड़ता है।

- फ) छात्रों द्वारा विद्यालय परिसर में किसी भी प्रकार के इलेक्ट्रॉनिक गैजेट/यंत्र, मोबाइल फोन, स्मार्ट घड़ियां आदि लाना/ उपयोग करना पूर्णतः वर्जित है। विद्यालय आने के लिए छात्रों द्वारा मोटर वाहनों का उपयोग / ड्राइव करना भी पूरी तरह से निषिद्ध है।
