

Greetings!

As per our past practices of the early start of the session, we have been able to address the learning gaps of the students to a great extent.

However, the rapidly increasing temperatures in the region may lead us to the directives to function for a limited time- slot during the day, in the month of April-May, 2022. Apart from this our school also serves to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, as a District Coordination Centre, Board Examination Centre & the Evaluation Centre. This is an essential and mandatory obligation on us as per the affiliation byelaws of the CBSE, wherein the school and its staff will be at the service of CBSE w.e.f. 23rd April, 2022 (Saturday).

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY MEASURES AND RULES

In order to maintain a safe and secure environment for all the bus-commuters, the following safety rules are mandatory to be followed by all the stakeholders:

1. Following the instructions: The students are under the authority of the escort teacher, driver and conductor while commuting in their school bus. Hence, they must follow the instructions issued by them regarding the seating arrangement/boarding/alighting from the bus / maintaining all the disciplinary aspects of commuting in the school bus. The bus drivers must not be disturbed by the students, at the time of driving, to avoid any untoward incident and ensure the safety of the bus commuters.

2. Punctuality and Safety: The commuters should reach their designated bus stops at least 5 minutes prior to the scheduled arrival of the designated bus ONLY. They should stand in a proper queue for boarding the bus and avoid fighting/rough play. Commuters should not run towards/ approach the bus until the bus stops and the conductor opens the door. They should never run after the bus once it departs the bus stop/ go under/ behind the bus.

3. Walking to/from the bus stop : After alighting at the designated bus stop, the student should go home directly, taking the safest route with the fewest streets to cross. If possible, the student should cross the desired streets and corners, using crosswalks and obey the traffic signals. *A student must never accept any offer of ride from a stranger.*

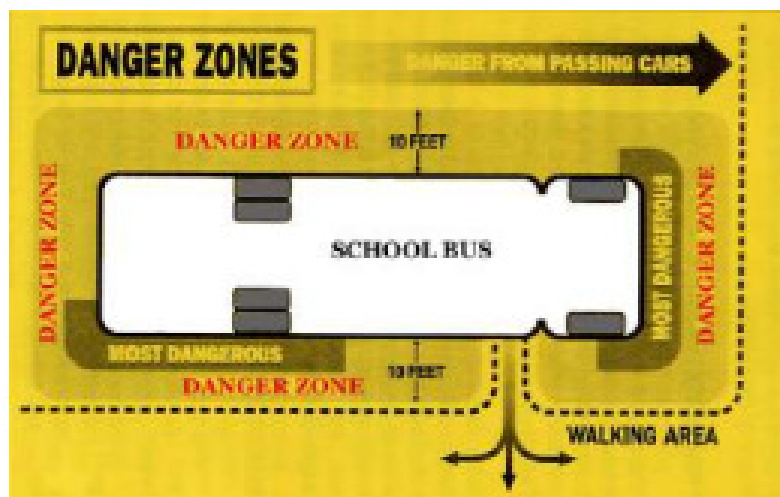
4. Prohibitions : Carrying bulky items leading to inconvenience to other fellow bus commuters; pushing/ pulling/destroying/damaging fixtures of the bus; shouting unnecessarily/using unparliamentary language; eating/spilling water/throwing wrappers of packed food items; playing/running across at a bus stop etc. are prohibited as these acts may cause harm to others. Non-compliance will lead to the withdrawal of Bus Facility of the concerned student.

5. Disciplinary Proceedings: Whenever any quarrel takes place in the bus or at a bus stop, it must be reported to the office of the school in writing.

Students who violate any of the rules and regulations will receive a negative Bus Conduct Report or a Yellow Card, and will be subjected to a normal progression of penalties. Vandalism in school buses may result in suspension or revocation of the student's riding privileges. Parents may be held financially liable for the cost of repairing the damage caused to school buses depending on the case.

6. Parents/Guardians/Escorts: While dropping their wards at the bus stop parents must ensure that, their vehicles are parked away from the loading and unloading zones of the school bus. Parents/Guardians/Escorts must not get into the bus for making their wards seated. Parents must ensure that ONLY the authorized person / escort is available for collecting heir wards at least 5 minutes prior to the arrival of bus at the respective bus stop. Parents should not get involved in arguments/ misbehave with any of the bus staff/ ask for any favors against the laid out rules & regulations. In case of any grievance, parents should talk to the concerned authority or report the same in person at the school office. Parents must not obstruct the movement of the school bus by chasing it or asking/ demanding it be stopped at any non- designated bus stop.

7. Stay out of the danger zone : The area around a school bus is called the Danger Zone. The students must stay out of this zone.



The bus facility is an extended service provided by the school. All concerned are expected to extend their cooperation for its smooth facilitation.
