Mapping the main physical features around the school to support the disaster management planning process. The final planning document includes a resource matrix, details of coping capacity, and list of safe places and evacuation plans. The School Disaster Management Plan is to be updated and evaluated at a fixed time each year. The young minds are most receptive to new ideas and need to be trained and made aware of certain basic principles that would not only save their lives but also being future citizens they play an important role towards nation building . Therefore, it is important to address disaster preparedness through fun activities in the school and promote the “culture of safety & preparedness” at a young age.
