







ENGLISH ELOCUTION COMPETITION

INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY-2021



ENGLISH EXTEMPORE COMPETITION










VIRTUAL SUMMER CAMP-2021









INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA-2021




FATHER'S DAY 2021_PPW




wonders for people battling mental issues and it also helps uplift one's mood. The Music Department of our school celebrated this occasion in their own joyful ways.


SANSKRIT SHLOKA RECITATION COMPETITION 2021



ENGLISH POETRY RECITATION COMPETITION 2021




Middle Wing










TEACHER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME-2021








PARENTAL INTERACTIVE SESSIONS WITH THE PRINCIPAL
