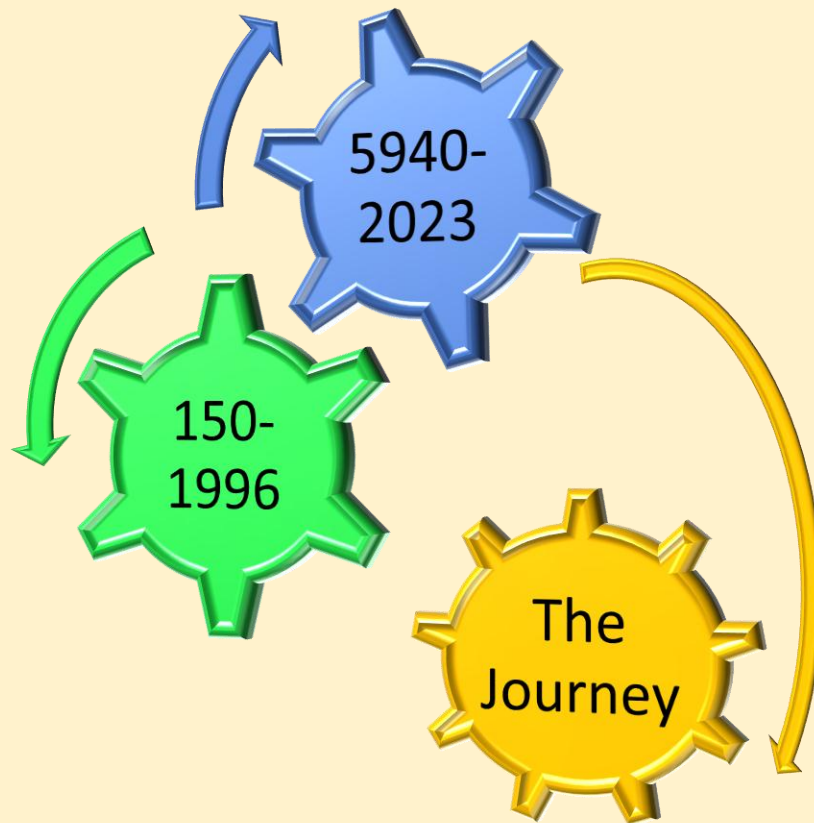


Patronage
