How does television affect our lives? It can be very helpful to the people who carefully choose the shows they watch. Television can increase our knowledge of the outside world. They are high quality programmes that help us to understand many fields of study science, medicine, arts and so on. Moreover, television benefits very old people, who cannot often leave the house as well as patients in the hospitals. It also offers non-native the advantage of daily informal language practice listening.

On the other hand there are several disadvantages of television. To many people, television becomes more real than reality and their own life seem boring. Many people get upset and depressed when they cannot solve the problem in real life as quickly as the television actors seem to.
