

UNFAIR MEANS (UFM) IN TESTS / EXAMINATIONS

Strict disciplinary action(s) shall be initiated against the child found intentionally involved in the unfair means during the conduct of various tests/examinations. Such disciplinary action may involve discontinuation of the student from school if the explanation is found insufficient / void / misleading. The following shall amount to Unfair Means:-

- * Talking to / consulting / disturbing other candidates inside/outside the examination room during the examination.

- * Being in possession of books, notes or any other prohibited material connected or not connected with the examination.

- * Taking breaks to move out of the allotted seat in the examination room without the permission of the invigilator.

- * Writing on desks, hands or other places and disturbing the seating arrangement for UFM purpose.

- * Exchanging question paper or answer sheets with another candidate.

- * Showing gestures or the answer sheet to another candidate framed and implemented by the school.
