Stone tools

Archaeologists have found some of the things hunters-gatherers made and used. It is likely that people made and used tools of stone, wood and bone, of which stone tools have survived best.

Some of these stone tools were used to cut meat and bone, scrape bark (from trees) and hides (animal skin), chop fruits and roots. Some may have been attached to handles of bone or wood, to make spears and arrows for hunting. Other tools were used to chop wood, which was used as firewood. Wood was also used to make huts and tools.
