

Community Outreach- A Report

The students of class XI (Humanities Section) of our school undertook a community outreach programme as a part of the “Swachhata Mission”. The idea was to reach out to the people of the rural areas and make our students understand the vibes.

Objectives of the mission:

- To learn about the socio economic conditions of a rural area
- To educate the villagers about health and hygiene and cleanliness
- To plant ‘Moringa’ saplings and to educate the villagers about the benefits of this miracle plant

Students as learners must witness and understand this intricate relationship between man and nature. A village survey was conducted, in which students collected first hand information on health status of the people. They collected information about immunization and sanitary conditions. They informed the villagers about the importance of maintaining cleanness to prevent diseases. They also educated specially women about the necessity of girls’ education in today’s world.

Different social welfare schemes which are formulated by the government, sometimes don’t reach to the people, because of ignoranance. Students covered around hundred homes and informed the villagers about ‘Ayushman Bharat’ programme too.

They planted around twenty saplings on different locations and took assurance from the villagers that the plants would be properly taken care.
