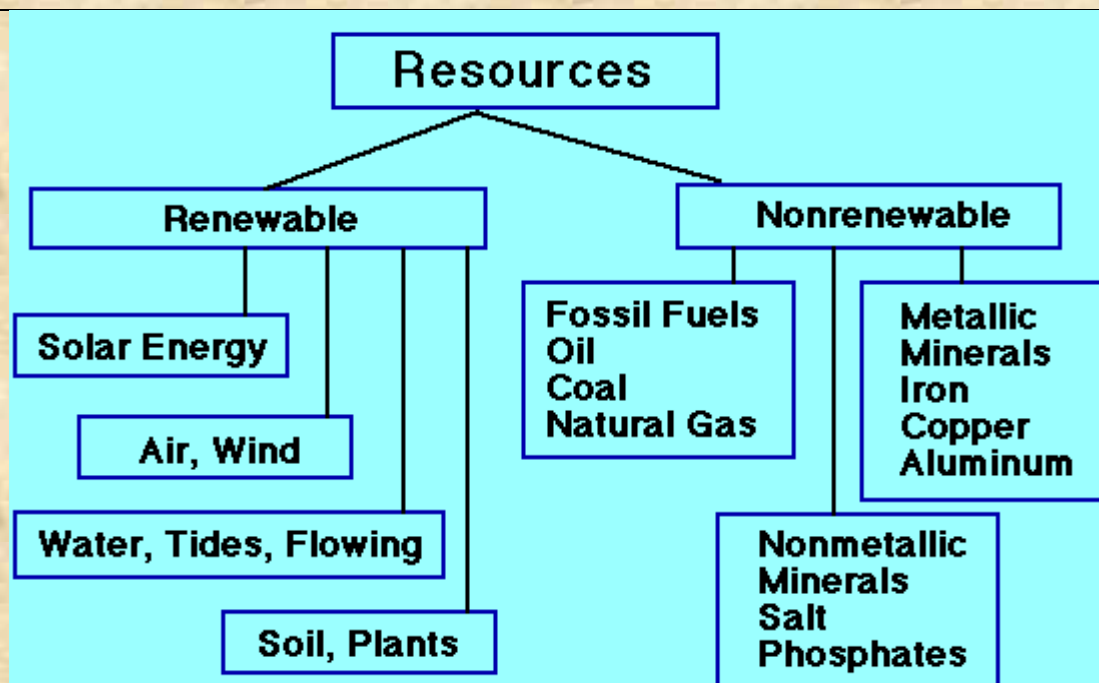
I GIVE ANSWER IN ONE WORD :-
