Descriptive Writing is a type of writing that is meant to describe a person, place, event, diary entry.

FORMAT-

HEADING

INTRODUCTION - Name, Age, Place where he belongs to, relationship with author, education, profession.

BODY - Characteristics, physical appearance, height, build, features, clothes (formal, casual), personality traits (intellectual, confident, sensitive)

CONCLUSION - Your feelings, opinions, what others think about him, his contribution to the society, his achievement.

NOTE

- Use similes + metaphors
- use descriptive adjectives like 'hunched shoulders', 'lanky fellow', 'oval faced', 'middle aged' etc
- There should be a sense of balance.
