4. **Monday** comes before Tuesday.
5. If today is Friday, then yesterday was **Thursday**.
6. If today is Thursday, then tomorrow will be **Friday**.
7. The third month of the year is **March**.
8. July comes before **August**.
9. October comes after **September**.
10. The eleventh month of the year is **November**.
11. In a leap year February has **29** days.
12. **April**, ^{June, September} and **November** months have 30 days.
13. The months of **July** and **August** have 31 days continuously.
14. 2 weeks together have **14** days.
15. The shortest month is **February**.
