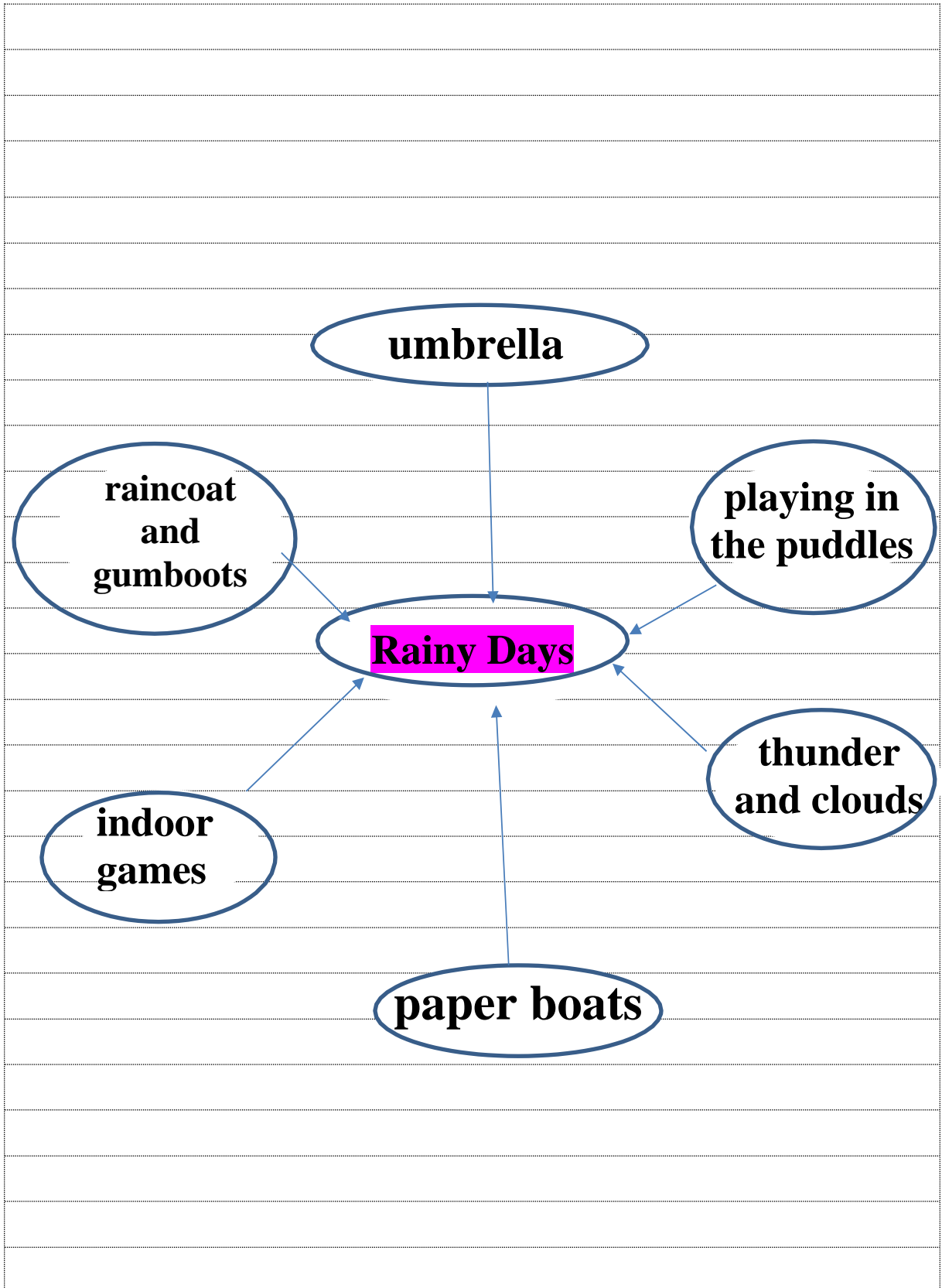
Ans. Rainy season is pleasing and cool for the people .
