Important points to remember-

1. **Society**- Society means a group of people who are linked together and depend on each other.
2. **Politics**- Politics is related to the rules by which a country is governed and the ways in which different political parties think it should be run. It influences the lives of the people of the country.
3. **Culture**- it is the sum of the habits, customs and tastes of the people of the country.
4. **Climatic zones**- There are three climatic zones of the earth-
 - i) **Frigid Zones**- Polar regions those are far from equator are known as frigid zones. These are very cold.
 - ii) **Torrid Zones**- They are near the equator is very hot as it gets direct rays of the sun throughout the year. This area is called the Torrid Zones.
 - iii) **Temperate Zones**- The area between the torrid and frigid zones where it is neither too hot nor too cold.

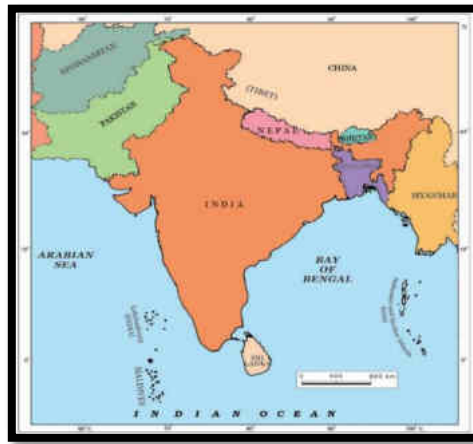
